**EMBALMING**

**\$675.00**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Utah Health Regulation requires burial or cremation take place within 24 hours of death, if no embalming, unless refrigeration is available at our funeral home. If deceased is taken out of the State of Utah or is being transported by common carrier, it must be embalmed.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as immediate burial or direct cremation. The Utah State Vital Statistics Act requires that disposition or burial take place within 24 hours where there is no embalming.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as immediate burial or direct cremation.

Utah law requires burial or cremation in 24 hours if no embalming, unless refrigeration is available. If body is being taken out of state or is being transported by common carrier it must be embalmed. Refrigeration is \$75 per day or portion thereof.

Utah law requires embalming or refrigeration if the body is not buried or cremated in twenty-four hours. If a body is being taken out of state, being transported by common carrier, or died from communicable disease, it must be embalmed.

**DIRECT CREMATION** .....

Our charge for direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes removal of remains, transportation to crematory in Salt Lake City, necessary services of staff and authorization. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard.

- A. Direct cremation with alternative container or container provided by purchaser ..... \$1800.00
- B. Direct cremation with casket selected from our funeral home (in addition to cost of casket) ..... \$1650.00

**DIRECT CREMATION**.....

\$ 2,595.00

This includes removal of the deceased from the home or hospital and minimum services of the funeral director and staff. We provide minimum alternate care without visitation or ceremony, as well as an alternative cremation container and temporary urn. This service includes cremation in our crematory, with delivery of the cremated remains to the family or a local cemetery. A cremation container is required to encase the body for the cremation process, which is done at our discretion and not that of the family. A wide range of cremation containers and urns are available for purchase in place of those provided, if desired.

**IMMEDIATE BURIALS**.....

Immediate burial is utilized when the means of final disposition is accomplished with the barest minimum of services provided by the funeral home and staff. This involves transfer of the deceased to the funeral home, alternate care of the deceased, basic facilities and limited professional services. We utilize a service vehicle to transport the casket to the cemetery, which is done at the convenience of the funeral home and cemetery. *This discounted package price is only available to families who purchase the casket from this mortuary.*

Direct Cremation:

This includes transfer of the deceased to the mortuary within 50 miles, services of funeral director and staff and transportation to crematory.
